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## ACOTE's Disclosure Statement regarding Probationary Accreditation Action:

The occupational therapy master's program at **Tuskegee University**, Tuskegee, Alabama, was placed on Probationary Accreditation effective **December 2, 2022**, for failure to document significant progress toward correction of an area of noncompliance related to 2018 Standard A.6.4 (certification exam pass rates).

On **April 3-4, 2023**, ACOTE conducted a fact-finding visit of the program to further assess compliance with the Standards.

At its **April 2023** meeting, ACOTE reviewed the results of the fact-finding visit and the Progress Report submitted by the occupational therapy master's program and determined that the program remains in noncompliance with 2018 Standard A.6.4 (certification exam pass rate). In addition, based on review of the 2023 Annual Report, ACOTE determined that the program was in noncompliance with 2018 Standards A.4.2 (published program outcomes), A.4.3 (published accreditation information), and A.4.4 (published policies). ACOTE voted to grant the program's request to extend the time frame for compliance with 2018 Standard A.6.4. until April 2024. The program's status remains Probationary Accreditation.

At its **August 2023** meeting, ACOTE reviewed the Plan of Correction and Progress Report submitted by the occupational therapy master's program and determined that the program returned to compliance with 2018 Standards A.4.2 (published program outcomes), A.4.3 (published accreditation information), and A.4.4 (published policies). However, the program remains in noncompliance with 2018 Standard A.6.4 (certification exam pass rate). The program's status remains Probationary Accreditation.

At its **December 2023** meeting, ACOTE reviewed the Progress Report submitted by the occupational therapy master's program and determined that the program remains in noncompliance with 2018 Standard A.6.4 (certification exam pass rate). The program's status remains Probationary Accreditation.

The program has been requested to submit a Progress Report to return the program to full compliance with the Standards within the mandated time period for correction.
