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ACOTE's Disclosure Statement regarding Probationary Accreditation Action:

The occupational therapy assistant program at **Concorde Career Institute-Miramar**, Miramar, Florida, was placed on Probationary Accreditation effective December 2, 2023, because the area of noncompliance related to 2018 Standard A.6.4 (certification exam pass rate) is so serious that the program's capability to provide acceptable educational experiences for the students is threatened.

At its **December 2024** meeting, ACOTE reviewed the Progress Report and Plan of Correction submitted by the occupational therapy assistant program and determined that the program returned to compliance with 2018 Standard A.2.9. (Sufficient Faculty), B.4.4. Standardized and Non-standardized Screening and Assessment Tools) and B.4.21.(Teaching–Learning Process and Health Literacy). However, the program remains in noncompliance with 2018 Standards A.2.1.(Program Director), A.2.3. (Program Director and Faculty Qualifications), A.2.14.(Library, Reference Materials, Instructional Aids, and Technology), A.2.15.(Distance Education), A.6.3. (Program Evaluation), A.6.4. (Certification Exam Pass Rate), B.1.1. (Human Body, Development, and Behavior), B.4.15. (Technology in Practice) and B.4.29. (Reimbursement Systems and Documentation).

At its **April 2025** meeting, ACOTE reviewed the Progress Report submitted by the occupational therapy assistant program and determined that the program returned to compliance with 2018 Standard A.2.1. (Program Director) and 2018 Standard A.2.3. (Program Director and Faculty Qualifications). However, the program remains in noncompliance with 2018 Standards A.2.14. (Library, Reference Materials, Instructional Aids, and Technology), A.2.15. (Distance Education), A.6.3. (Program Evaluation), A.6.4. (Certification Exam Pass Rate), B.1.1. (Human Body, Development, and Behavior), B.4.15. (Technology in Practice), and B.4.29. (Reimbursement Systems and Documentation). ACOTE voted to change the status of the program from Probationary Accreditation to **Probationary Accreditation-Inactive**, effective April 5, 2025. The program has been requested to submit an Inactive Status Report that includes information on the number of students remaining in the program, their status in the program, and resources (including faculty), for ensuring a quality education for those remaining students.
