

ACOTE's Disclosure Statement regarding *Probationary Accreditation Action*:

*The occupational therapy assistant program at **Goodwin University**, East Hartford, Connecticut, was placed on Probationary Accreditation effective **April 6, 2025**, because the area of noncompliance related to 2018 Standard A.6.4. (Certification Exam Pass Rate) is so serious that the program's capability to provide acceptable educational experiences for the students is threatened.*

*At its **August 2025** meeting, ACOTE reviewed the Progress Report and the institution's request to have the occupational therapy assistant program at Goodwin University, East Hartford, Connecticut, placed on Inactive status. ACOTE granted the request and changed the status of the program from Probationary Accreditation to **Probationary Accreditation-Inactive**, effective August 1, 2025. Furthermore, ACOTE determined that the program remains in noncompliance with 2023 Standard A.6.4. (Certification Exam Pass Rate) and requested a Progress Report to return the program to full compliance with the Standard within the mandated time period for correction.*

*At its **December 2025** meeting, ACOTE reviewed the Progress Report and determined that the program remains in noncompliance with 2023 Standard A.6.4. (Certification Exam Pass Rate).*

*At its **April 2026** meeting, ACOTE reviewed the Progress Report and determined that the program remains in noncompliance with 2023 Standard A.6.4. (Certification Exam Pass Rate).*

The program has been requested to submit a subsequent Progress Report to return the program to full compliance with the Standard within the mandated time period for correction, as well as an updated Inactive Status Report documenting continued progress of the teach-out plan for the remaining students.
