

ACOTE's Disclosure Statement regarding *Probationary Accreditation Action*:

*The occupational therapy assistant program at **Ross College in Hopkinsville**, Hopkinsville, Kentucky, was placed on Probationary Accreditation effective **March 23, 2024**, because the area of noncompliance related to 2018 Standard A.6.4 (certification exam pass rate) is so serious that the capability of the program to provide acceptable educational experiences for the students is threatened.*

*On **November 6-7, 2024**, ACOTE conducted a fact-finding visit to the program to further assess compliance with the Standards.*

*At its **December 2024** meeting, ACOTE reviewed the Fact-Finding Report submitted by the occupational therapy assistant program and determined that it remains in noncompliance with 2018 Standard A.6.1. (Strategic Plan), A.6.3. (Program Evaluation) and A.6.4. (Certification Exam Pass Rate).*

*At its **April 2025** meeting, ACOTE reviewed the revised Plan of Correction submitted by the occupational therapy assistant program and determined that the program returned to compliance with 2018 Standards A.6.1. (Strategic Plan) and A.6.3. (Program Evaluation). However, the program remains in noncompliance with 2018 Standard A.6.4. (Certification Exam Pass Rate).*

*At its **August 2025** meeting, ACOTE reviewed the Progress Report submitted by the occupational therapy assistant program and determined that the program remains in noncompliance with 2023 Standard A.6.4. (Certification Exam Pass Rate).*

*At its **December 2025** meeting, ACOTE reviewed the Report of On-Site Evaluation and determined that the program remains in noncompliance with 2023 Standard A.6.4. (Certification Exam Pass Rate) and cited additional areas of noncompliance relative to 2023 Standards A.3.1. (Admission Criteria), A.3.2. (Admission Policies), B.2.9. (Personal and Professional Responsibilities), B.2.11. (Leadership), and B.4.3. (Documentation of Services).*

*The program has been requested to submit Plans of Correction and a Progress Report to return the program to full compliance with the Standards within the mandated time period for correction.*
